

CROATIA IN SAILBOAT

INTRODUCTION

Welcome everyone to the sailboat trip to Croatia 2018!

This is a “place to place” trip where we will cross numerous of islands located between the city of Dubrovnik and Split. During one week, we will sail through the maximum interesting places of the region and we will stay during the nights by the different charming ports, or anchored.



TRIP DATES

From the 4th to the 11th or 11th to 18th of August 2018.

- **Day and hour of embarkation:** Saturday at 2:00 p.m., ACI marina, Dubrovnik.
- **Day and hour of disembarkation:** Saturday at 09:00a.m., ACI marina, Dubrovnik.



ROUTE AND LOGISTICS

Saturday the 4th or 11th of August, we will meet at 2p.m. at the ACI Marina port of Dubrovnik, located 5km away from the city. Next, we will all go to buy the provisions for the week and we are going to organize everything in the boat. We will do the check-in and distribute all the cabins. Right after, the skipper is going to explain all the details for the trip and the life on board. When all the travel preparations are done the same Saturday in the afternoon, we will leave and we will go northbound.



Knowing that the route is going to depend on the wind and other factors, we will try to travel around during one week through the islands such as: Koločep, Lopud, Sipan, Mljet, Korčula, Lastovo, and if the meteorology allows it, the Vis Island. We are going to return to the port the 10th or 17th of August, and at the afternoon we are going to visit the old quarter of Dubrovnik. At night we will have the farewell dinner there. On the 11th or 18th at 9a.m. we will leave the boat and we will consider our trip finished.

In the day by day, after having breakfast, we sail during two hours after the next corner where we will bathe and eat. Later on, we normally sail two hours more until the place we are going to stay during the night, which are usually beautiful caves or small charming ports.

All this area have really calmed waters with not too much waves, which is ideal for the navigation to be more relaxed and for the people that has a tendency to get seasick.

During the trip, we have some excursions planned to natural parks and really beautiful towns of the area.

SAILBOAT AND NAVIGATION

The boat we are going to sail with will be the Jeanneau 53. This is a really comfortable and safe sailing boat. It has five cabins plus two seats in the living room, offering a maximum capacity of 12 people. The spaces are a really wide thanks to its 16 meters in length. It is one of the largest and comfortable boat that are used nowadays by charter.

In case of encountering complicated sea or wind conditions, the captain reserves the right to remain in the port or modify the route.
